ON THE SCIENCE FRONT

We have begun our study on the skeletal system.

On Tuesday we will finish up a previously started lesson from the textbook. We will also label some diagrams which are to be *retained and studied* for our skeleton test.

We will also watch a video aimed at helping us remember the bones easier. *I have put links to three such videos in our Google Classroom so students may access them from home.*

On Tuesday or Wednesday, we will label the bones of our paper skeletons, cut them out and begin assembling them in groups. We will have 3 completed skeletons when finished.

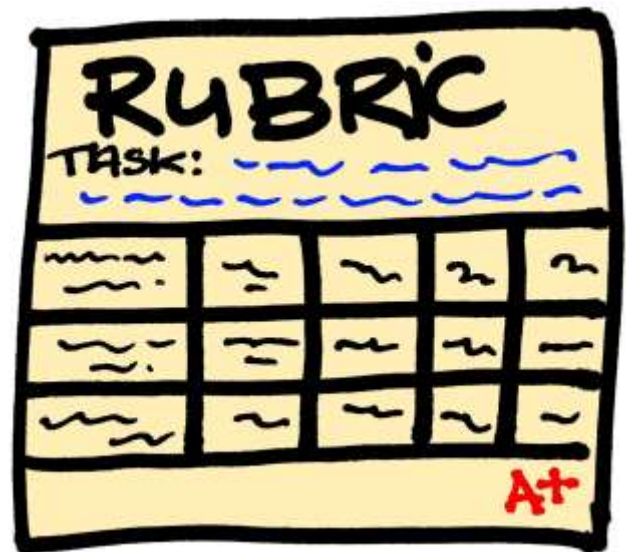
We will also explore the different types of joints we have in our skeleton system and how they work, most likely on Thursday.
