

Our Preschool Day

Our preschool day includes a variety of full group, small group and individual activities. The goal is to provide a loving, nurturing environment in which children can explore and discover. We infuse movement throughout the day and take a child's attention span into consideration. The schedule may be adjusted for special events and we include activities with the Spanish, music, P.E. and art teachers monthly.

Time	Activity	We Are Learning
8:05	Arrival	When children arrive, staff members help them get out of the car and into the building. Students follow a morning routine: say goodbye, put belongings away, answer the question of the day and sign in.
	Table Time	Children complete an activity at the table that corresponds to our theme. They are learning literacy, math, science, art, and fine motor skills.
8:20	Group Time	We start the day with welcoming friends and a prayer. Then we review the calendar and schedule and talk about our day. We recognize special days and events and listen to a story.
8:35	Centers Play/Theme Activities	Our learning centers provide intentional playtime individually or with a friend: art, science, blocks, library, dress up, store, and discovery are a few of the centers. Themed activities are rotated in to provide diverse options and to reinforce learning.
9:20	Music	Music time is filled with songs, rhymes, movement, and playing instruments. Through music, we build social and pre-academic skills along with gross motor skills.
9:30	Snack	All children wash their hands and use the restroom if needed. Snack gives students opportunity to learn math concepts and social interaction.
9:45	Outdoor/Large Motor	Various activities are set up on the playground or indoors to practice gross motor skills. Students choose activities to help them to explore and discover nature and expend energy.
10:15	Small Group	Children meet in smaller groups with a teacher to reinforce learning in math, literacy, science or writing. They enjoy making and using hands-on activities.
10:45	Bible Time	Students hear a Bible story and interact with the truth. They learn to pray for each other and find ways to apply the truth they are learning. Together they memorize a Bible verse to hide God's Word in their hearts.
11:05-11:15	Dismissal	Children help clean up, pack their belongings and say goodbye to teachers and friends. The staff help children get into their car.
